Application Checklist:

- Online Application Form:** Available at www.kgi.edu.
- Application Fee:** \$75 fee, payable online, or by check or money order to the address below.
- Resume:** Educational background and professional experience.
- Personal Statement:** Describe how the MBS program will enhance your future career options and increase your skill set for a career in the life science industry. (Maximum 3 pages, double spaced)
- Supplemental Essay:** Please discuss the MBS major in which you have the most interest. The five different majors include Pharmaceutical Discovery and Development, Business of Bioscience, Clinical and Regulatory Affairs, Medical Device and Diagnostics, and Bioprocessing. (Maximum 1 page, double-spaced)
- Official Transcripts/Marksheets:** Unofficial transcripts may be submitted for evaluation purposes. If admitted and you choose to matriculate, official transcripts must be submitted from all colleges or universities attended. (Translated copies must be submitted for International students)
- Official GRE/GMAT/MCAT Scores:** ETS School code—4166.
- International Applicants:** A test of English proficiency is required for those who attended an institution in a country where English is not the native language. (Tests accepted include: TOEFL, IELTS, PTE, and iTEP)
- Two Letters of Reference (3rd Letter Optional):** These letters should be from a science faculty member, advisor or previous supervisor.
- Admissions Interview:** In-person, Skype or phone interviews will be conducted.
