Grade of "C" or better in each prerequisite course.

Science courses must be no more than 10 years old.

Create a PharmCAS account and apply online

Priority Deadline: December 1; Final Deadline: June 1

Applicants are encouraged to apply by the Priority Deadline for priority consideration for merit-based scholarships and to be considered for the Presidential Access Scholarship for community college students.

Applicants should submit the following directly to PharmCAS:

- One Letter of Recommendation or contact information for one Professional Reference.
- Official transcripts from all colleges attended. If the transcript is from a school outside the U.S., official course-by-course evaluations should be submitted.
- Personal statement (see PharmCAS application for prompt)

Applicants must be a U.S. citizen or Permanent Resident
